CMR Course – Tuesday 19 April 2016 – Information

This course has been designed to provide the clinical cases required for level 1 CMR accreditation. The aim of the course is to provide access to 50 cases plus 25 spot cases to augment your portfolio. The course cannot provide exhaustive training and assumes some core knowledge. We are pleased to announce that BSCMR members will also soon have access to free online educational cases to further augment your CMR training portfolio.

Level 1 accreditation can be achieved by combining this course with CMR course lectures and hands-on CMR scanning/workstation training to be provided at the British Cardiovascular Society (BCS) Annual Conference, which takes place 6–8 June 2016.

Details on how to sign up for the training at the BCS Annual Conference will be provided to attendees at the Exeter CMR course; places will be provided on a first-come, first-served basis.

Attendants who complete both the Exeter CMR course and the training at the BCS Annual Conference will be issued with a joint BSCMR and BCS level 1 CMR certificate.

Cancellation

Travel

Access to Exeter/the Campus is as follows:

Train: Exeter St David's (main line station) is only 5 minutes away by bus/taxi or a 10-minute walk from Streatham Campus. The average journey time from London Paddington to Exeter is 2 hours 30 minutes.

Direct flights: These operate into Exeter from several airports in the UK including Aberdeen, Belfast, Edinburgh, Glasgow, Guernsey, Jersey, Leeds/Bradford, Manchester, Newcastle, Norwich and St Mary's. International flights also operate from Paris, Dublin, Amsterdam, Geneva.

Car: The M4/M5 links Exeter directly to London, the Midlands, South Wales and the North including Scotland. The average journey time from either London or the Midlands is 3 hours. Parking is free of charge if you stay in Holland Hall.
